
BENEFITS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION & HEALTH EDUCATION





Cosponsor the PHYSICAL Act

- ★ The Promoting Health as
 Youth Skills in the Classroom
 Act would amend the
 Elementary and Secondary
 Education Act (ESEA) to
 recognize physical education
 and health education as
 core academic subjects,
 allowing schools to use a
 greater pool of funds for
 these programs.
- ★ Reauthorizes PEP—a competitive grant program that funds innovative physical education programs in schools—as a stand-alone program in ESEA.

Well-Rounded Education

- ★ Include health education and physical education within the definition of "well-rounded education" in the reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act.
- ★ Well-Rounded Education— The term "well-rounded education" may include activities that:
 - prepare students to be college, career, and citizenship-ready;
 - provide access to social and emotional learning and supports;
 - allow access to a complete education that provides knowledge and skills in all subject disciplines which may include reading, math, science, health education, physical education, art, music, history, civics, finance, foreign languages, and geography.
